

OMA reports a 4.0% increase in August 2026 passenger traffic

Mexico City, Mexico, September 4, 2026—Mexican airport operator Grupo Aeroportuario del Centro Norte, S.A.B. de C.V., known as OMA (NASDAQ: OMAB; BMV: OMA), reports that terminal passenger traffic at its 13 airports increased 4.0% in August 2026, as compared to August 2025. Domestic traffic increased 3.5 %, and international traffic increased 7.0%.
